Tuition fees are invoiced at the beginning of each of the following periods: in September (4 months), January (3 months) and April (3 months) (each, a “Financial Period”).

Every Financial Period a student commences must be paid for in full. In the event the student ceases to be enrolled at FIS during the Financial Period for any reason whatsoever, no reimbursement shall be granted.

### Siblings discount

A 10% discount on tuition fees is granted for the third child enrolled with FIS, and a 15% discount for the fourth child or additional children.

### New applicants

Application fee: \$2,800 per student, non-refundable and non-transferable, paid upon application for admission.

Assessment fees:

- For pupils applying to French stream bilingual classes: \$500 per student, non-refundable and non-transferable
- For pupils applying to International stream classes: \$1,000 per student, non-refundable and non transferable

Advance payment: In order to confirm a place, a non-refundable and non-transferable advance payment of \$25,000 per student for tuition fees has to be made to FIS.

## Departures

Parents shall submit the Student Withdrawal Notice to FIS within the following time periods:

- On or before 31st October for withdrawals before the end of the 1st Financial Period;
- On or before 31st January for withdrawals before the end of the 2nd Financial Period;
- On or before 31st March for withdrawals before the end of the 3rd Financial Period.

Failure to submit the Student Withdrawal Notice within the prescribed deadline will result in a fee being imposed as payment in lieu of notice for the period from the relevant withdrawal notice deadline date until the date of receipt of the late notice, in accordance with the following amounts:

- up to one month late: 1 month of the applicable School Fees,
- more than one month late: 2 months of the applicable School Fees.

## Others

### Materials

School and PE uniforms are provided and invoiced by independent suppliers. All orders and payments shall be sent directly to them.

The FIS PE summer uniform is mandatory for all students and should be ordered from Uniform Station Ltd. More details at <https://www.fis.edu.hk/en/sports>.

From time to time, FIS proposes optional materials or services such as dental visits, yearbooks and UCAS applications. Applicable fees are communicated on a case-by-case basis.

For renewal of lost Access Card, the replacement cost is \$100.

## Outings

Students may be involved in outings or in extended overnight field trips whether locally or abroad, some of which are an integral part of the curriculum. Participation fees may be invoiced for such outings and trips.

## Extra-Curricular Activities

Primary level activities are semester based. Secondary level activities are for the full Academic Year. Once an activity is started, activity fees must be paid in full irrespective of whether such activity is completed.

## Debentures

Corporate debenture	\$250,000
Private debenture	\$90,000

One debenture for each child attending FIS must be either nominated or acquired before entry. The full debenture amount must be settled in June for school intake that August or September.

All debentures are refundable. FIS is entitled to postpone repayment for a period of ten (10) years.

FIS reserves the right to deduct any outstanding monies from the redemption value of the debenture.

### **Corporate debenture, category A**

Category A debentures are to be purchased by a company registered in Hong Kong.

These corporate debentures are transferable to another pupil upon payment of a reallocation fee of \$25,000.

A reallocated debenture must be upgraded to the current value, as necessary, prior to the student starting at FIS.

## Private debenture, category B

Category B debentures are for families paying their child's school fees. No corporate payment is accepted for this debenture or student school fees when a private debenture is chosen.

This debenture is not transferable to another pupil.

## Terms of payment

All invoices shall be paid within thirty (30) days after the date of the invoice issued by FIS.

All payments to be made to FIS in accordance with the Terms and Conditions shall be made in the currency as designated on the invoice. Any charges (including but not limited to bank transfer charges, foreign exchange conversion charges...) shall be borne by the debtor.

Parents and corporates agree and undertake to pay to FIS interest on any overdue amounts at the rate of one (1) per cent per calendar month from the due date until payment if the Parents or corporates shall fail to pay any amounts due under this Contract by the due date.
