

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) Results

Students can access their IBDP results at 2000 on 6 July. They must log onto the following website using **Mozilla Firefox**: <https://candidates.ibo.org>

Students will be given individual access codes and passwords.

The IBDP certificates will be sent to school in late August. Students can either collect them in person or notify the school of an address that they wish the certificate to be sent to. This arrangement will be confirmed before the students sit their exams in May.

Mr Hammond and Mrs Hall will be in school to offer support on 8 July (0900-1200). Mr. Hammond will be able to advise on university issues, and Mrs. Hall on remark/retake issues. This gives the students a day to think about their results and the questions they would like answered. Please note that Mr Clayton will be in school on 7 July to offer immediate support.

Other key dates:

Mr Hammond and Mrs Hall will be available to support our students via email between 7th and 13th July (immediately after the receipt of results). They will then be available between 25th July and 1st August, and between 24th August and 9th September, for further email queries.

- Please note that retake requests must be made via Mrs Hall before 13 July.
- Requests for remarks (Enquiry Upon Results) must be made via Mrs Hall by 9 September.

Please note that Mrs Hall and Mr Hammond will have access to all subject results and will be able to offer advice about each subject. Please do not contact individual teachers. If Mrs Hall or Mr Hammond feel that advice is needed from a subject teacher, they will contact that teacher.

IGCSE Results

Students can access their IGCSE results on 10 August. They must log onto the following website: myresults.cie.org.uk

Students will be given individual access codes and passwords.

The IGCSE certificates will be sent to school by the end of October. They will be distributed in school. For students who are leaving FIS they should notify the school of an address that they wish the certificate to be sent to before their exams in May.

If a student has any enquiries about their results these can be made to Mrs Hall **in person** immediately upon return to school after the summer holiday. If a student has left FIS, they can email Mrs Hall at phall@lfis.edu.hk from 31 August. If a student is considering a remark, they must communicate this to Mrs Hall before 9 September.

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
