

FIS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2 YEAR IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

Two **full or partial scholarships** are available for students entering Year 12 of the International Stream. **Applications must be submitted by 16 March 2018 and successful applicants will be informed on 16 April 2018.**

When do I have to apply for a scholarship?

Candidates must submit the required documents and form along with their application for enrolment to the International Stream Admissions office.

Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Head of the International Stream and the Head of Secondary School International Stream. Applications must be submitted by 16 March 2018 and successful applicants will be informed on 16 April 2018.

What is the duration of the scholarship?

Scholarships are awarded for the duration of the **two year IB Diploma Programme**, subject to an academic and financial review at the end of the first year. During this period, recipients will be expected to maintain an agreed grade average which will be reviewed after the first year. Students will also be expected to contribute to school life and show exemplary conduct.

What does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship granted will fully or partially cover the following expenses: debenture in full, school fees, compulsory school trips and outings and enrolment to one FIS extra-curriculum activity. For external candidates applying for this Scholarship, FIS will waive the entrance assessment fees.

Selection Criteria

Academic excellence and financial need are the 2 main criteria for awarding a scholarship; other considerations include whether the candidate is from a local school, an external school, or is a permanent resident of HKSAR.

All external candidates applying for a Scholarships must satisfy the following criteria:

- Successful entrance examination in Mathematics, English and CAT4 online test.
- Explain in a 300 hundred word essay why they believe that they are the best candidate for the Scholarship. (email to scholarship@lfis.edu.hk)
- Achieve (or be expected to achieve) excellent grades in the IGCSE examinations (or equivalent) and display consistency in his/her academic performance over the last 2 years. School transcripts or reports from September 2016 onwards must be provided.

Please note that children of FIS staff are not encouraged to apply as FIS has school fee subsidy schemes for staff in place already.

The following documents are required at the time of application:

- Student ID picture
- Student passport
- Student Visa or HK ID card
- School reports for the last 2 years
- 300 hundred words essay why they believe that they are the best candidate for the scholarship.

If the applicant is selected for interview and examination, the following documents will be required:

- Inland Revenue Annual Return for both parents
- 6 last salary slips of both parents
- Proof of housing allowance if applicable
- Proof of education allowance if applicable
- Copy of your rental agreement or property certificate
