# HELPING STUDENTS PREPARE FOR THE WIDER WORLD

In 1988 the French International School (FIS) was the first in Hong Kong to be authorised as an IB World School. In the 29 years since then, FIS has amassed a wealth of experience guiding students to reach their potential in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBDP). FIS students consistently outperform international averages; in 2016, one student attained the coveted 45 points (the highest possible mark) and 30% achieved 40 points or more.

This year, students have already received offers to continue their education next academic year at some of the most prestigious universities worldwide including the University of Cambridge, the University of Oxford, King's College, UCL, Dartmouth College, the University of British Columbia and The University of Hong Kong."

The vision of FIS is to provide an inspiring, high quality of education for students from Hong Kong's culturally diverse community. This vision is driven forward by excellent, dedicated teachers from all over the world who ensure that a challenging and nurturing educational environment is provided. FIS is also keen to ensure that the school is accessible to external students demonstrating academic excellence by offering two full IBDP scholarships annually.

The attributes of the IB learner profile permeate the entire school and relate closely to the FIS Personal Profile: **IPROMISE** (Inquirers, Principled, Risk-takers, Open-minded, Mindful, Innovative, Smart, Empathetic). Our teachers and parents work closely together to build a community where every student is cared for and valued. Small class sizes ensure that close attention can be paid to a student's needs and their individual development. Each IBDP class has two form tutors offering for one-on-one time and the students also receive personal and academic support from a Director of Welfare and Learning.

The wellbeing of students is a major focus at FIS. Physical and emotional wellbeing is at the heart of our IBDP Induction Programme and this



continues throughout the following two years until our students graduate. "We aim to have healthy students that can look after their own wellbeing during school and beyond. As well as our excellent academic provision, guidance is offered through our IBDP Support Sessions which take place during weekly PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) classes. These Support Sessions also allow time to focus on transferable skills: communication, research, collaboration, thinking and self-management skills – all vital for success not only in the IBDP but also at university and beyond in our personal and work lives" explained Pauline Hall, IBDP Coordinator at FIS. Students also have access to many extracurricular activities and participate in a compulsory dynamic sports programme where the emphasis is on enhancing students' understanding and application of health and fitness for life.

Next year will be our 30<sup>th</sup> year as an IB World School and for many years to come, FIS will continue to encourage students to reach their full academic potential while developing the necessary skills and attributes required for their future endeavours.
